

How to export your collection for use in my programs

There are a few different options

Manual export

- Select *File / Export Profile Database* from the menu
- Click *Accept* at the usage policy
- Select *Single file* and name it something with an extension of .xml
- Select a suitable directory where to save the export file
- Click *Next*
- Under *Export selection* you probably want to select *All* or *Owned*
- Select everything under *Optional Export Data*
- Click *Export*

Using a command file

If you expect to export your collection more than just a few times, a command file will make that a whole lot simpler. A command file is a text file with commands for DVD Profiler. Example:

```
CollectionType Owned
ClearAllFilters
ExportXMLFiltered E:\DvdProfilerExport\Owned.xml
```

This is my command file for exporting my owned collection. Obviously you should change the third line to a filename that suits you. Put this in a text file and save it with a suitable name, for example `ExportOwned.txt`.

To export using the command file, just select *File / Run Command File* from the menu and select your command file. The export will run without any more interaction.

Using DvdpScheduler

If you keep your PC running over night, you can use my program [DvdpScheduler](#) to schedule an automatic export of your collection. You can also use it for one-click exports on demand.
